Report Highlights:

The Russian federal Customs Service published Order No. 269 on April 4, 2008 revising the list of declaration points in the Russian Far East Customs Directorate and the North West Customs Directorate which have historically handled more than 85 percent of the total Russian meat imports but left off the important port of Magadan. Order No 269 goes into effect April 15, 2008.

Summary

The Russian Federal Customs Service (Customs) published Order No. 269 on April 4, 2008, revising the list of declaration points for imported meat and meat products. This new order amends Order No. 1283, dated October 17, 2007. The revised list includes several new customs declaration points in the Russian Far East Customs Directorate and the North West Customs Directorate which have historically handle more than 85 percent of total Russian meat imports but conspicuously left off the important Russian Far East port of Magadan. Order No. 269 goes into effect April 15, 2008. An informal translation of the decree follows.

Text of the Decree

Order of the Federal Customs Service No. 269 (March 17, 2008)

In order to effectively control the enforcement of Customs legislation of the Russian Federation and clarify the approved points of declaration for certain types of commodities, on the basis of paragraph 2 of Article 101 and subparagraph 3 of paragraph 2 Article 125 of the Customs Code of the Russian Federation (Collected Legislation of the Russian Federation, 2003, No. 22, p. 2066, No. 52 (part 1), p. 5038; 2004, No. 27, p. 2711, No. 34, Art. 3533, No. 46 (part 1), p. 4494; 2005, No. 30 (part 1), p. 3101; 2006, No. 1, p. 15, No. 3, p. 280, No. 8, p. 854, No. 52 (part 2), p. 5504; 2007, No. 1 (part 1), p. 29, No. 24, p. 2831, No. 27, p. 3213, No. 31, p.3995, p. 4011, No 45 p.5417) I order:

Include the attachment to Customs Order No. 1283 (October 17, 2007) "On Points for declaring certain types of commodities" (registered by the Russian Ministry of Justice on November 7, 2007, registration No. 10433). With amendments, Customs Order No. 1642 (December 28, 2007) (registered by the Russian Ministry of Justice on January 23, 2008, registration No. 10976) should read in accordance with this attachment.

This Order goes into effect April 15, 2008.
